To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, for and in consideration of the sum of *Five Dollars* for every hundred acres hereby granted, paid into our treasury by *Allen Anderson* have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said *Allen Anderson* a tract of land containing *One hundred* acres, lying and being in the county of *Craven on the North side of Neuse River and*

South side of Swift Creek, beginning at a maple on the South side of the Great Bay Bush and runs with the same South sixty seven East forty poles to a stake thence South twenty two West thirty two poles to a pine thence South forty three East one hundred and thirty five poles to a pine on the South side of Bearhole Swamp near the paperway thence with the same South eighty five East one hundred and sixty poles to a pine thence South twelve West eighteen, eighteen poles to a pine on the North side of the Sand Hill Bay Bush Swamp thence with the same North eighty five West one hundred and fifty poles to a pine thence North forty two West one hundred and fifty poles to a small juniper on the North side of the Juniper Swamp thence South forty six West one hundred and twelve poles to a pine on the South West side of the Juniper Swamp thence South fifty five East thirty five poles to a pine stake thence South fourteen West fifty seven poles to a pine thence North sixty three West sixty two poles thence North fourteen East one hundred and eighty five poles thence to the beginning

Entered the 25th of October 1837

as by the plat hereunto annexed doth appear, together with all woods, waters, mines, minerals, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said land belonging or appertaining: TO HOLD to the said *Allen Anderson his* heirs and assigns forever: Yielding and paying to us such sums of money, yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from time to time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said grantee shall cause this grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of *Craven* within twelve months from the date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void.

In Testimony whereof, We have caused these our letters to be made patent, and our Great Seal to be hereunto affixed.
