

State of North Carolina. No. 2657.

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars for every hundred acres hereby granted, paid into our treasury by Allen Anderson have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Allen Anderson a tract of land containing Fifty two acres, lying and being in the county of Craven on the North side of Neuse river and South side of Swift Creek beginning at a dead pine on the North prong of Poplar Branch Williams' corner thence along his line South thirty Nint one hundred poles to Allens home line thence along the said home line and the various courses of the branch to the fork, and thence up the North prong to the beginning.

Entered the 22nd day of May 1842.

as by the plat hereunto annexed doth appear, together with all woods, waters, mines, minerals, heriditaments, and appurtenances to the said land belonging or appertaining: TO HOLD to the said Allen Anderson his heirs and assigns forever: Yielding and paying to us such sums of money, yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from time to time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said grantee shall cause this grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said County of Craven within twelve months from the date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void.

In Testimony whereof, We have caused these our letters to be made patent, and our Great Seal to be hereunto affixed. Witness, John M. Morehead Esquire, our Governor, Captain-General and Commander in Chief, at RALEIGH, the 22nd day of December in the 16th year of our Independence, and in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three.
