mines, minerals, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said Land belonging
or appertain. To hold to the said John Leonard his Heirs and assigns for ever yielding
and paying to us such sums of money, yearly or other wise, as our general assembly
from time to time may direct, Provided always, that the said John Leonard
shall cause this Grant to be Registered in the Register's Office of our said County
of Craven within twelve Months from the date hereof other wise the same shall be
void and of none effect. In witness where of, we have caused these our letters to be

every Hundred Acres hereby Granted, paid into our Treasury by Joseph
Anderson - have given and granted and by these presents do give and
grant unto the said Joseph Anderson - a tract of Land, containing
one Hundred & seventy five - Acres, Lying and being in the County of
Craven on the North side of Neuse River and near Kemps Ferry Beginning
in James Kemps little patent line at Dobbs Corner a pine by the Road and runs
with Kemps line North forty five East ninety two pole to a stake then South
seventy seven East thirty pole to a small pine said Kemps Corner in Matthias
Kemps old line then with the same North forty five East forty four pole
to a black jack then South forty five East forty one pole to a pine then North
eighty East sixty four pole to the Creek Pocason then along the Pocason to
the forty nine West fifty five pole North thirty four West twenty pole then
North thirty one East eighteen pole to Joshua Kemps Beginning corner
pine then with his line South seventy West sixty pole to a black jack
his corner then with his other line North seventy west one Hundred & eighty
eight pole to a pine then North thirty one west thirty two pole to a pine in Kemps
line then south twenty four West thirty four pole to a gum then South
