This Indenture made this fifteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven. Between Benjamin Brinson Planter of the one part and Samuel Sparrow Ship Carpenter of the other both of the County and State aforesaid Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Brinson for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds good and lawfull Money to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof the said Benjamin Brinson doth hereby acknowledge himself therewith fully satisfied contented & paid hath granted bargained & sold and set over unto the said Samuel Sparrow his heirs and assigns a piece or parcel of Land lying and being in the County & State aforesaid on the North side of Neuse River and East side of Guse Creek being part of a patent granted to Jason Brinson sen^r in the year 1770 Beginning at a small Gum in Benjamin Sparrow and Samuel Sparrow's line and runs East 102 poles to a pine then North 40 East 100 pole to a stake in the edge of the savans between three Gums marked sited towards St. thence South 76 west to Sam^l Sparrow's own line, then with his own line to the first station containing by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less. To have and to hold the aforesaid bargained premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereunto belonging with the appertinences unto the S^r Samuel Sparrow his heirs and assigns to his or their only proper use & behoof forever and he the S^r Benjⁿ Brinson for himself his heirs the aforesaid bargained premises and every part and parcel thereunto belonging against him and his heirs and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the said Samuel Sparrow his heirs and assigns do warrant and forever defend by these premises. Corner of a tract of 220 Acres of Land granted to Robert Shrieve
by patent bearing date the 10th of September 1707 & runs with the line
of said patent N^o 64 w^t 36 poles, then west 10 North 30 poles, then N^o 11 W^t
100 poles.
