To the worshipfull Inferior Cort of Pleas and Quater Session to be held in the town of Newbern on the second Tuesday in Septembe 1768 Wee your humbal petitioners pray this favour of your Worships - that if your pleasure be that the place of new Road Laid out over the head of Goos Creek shall Remain Whare it is that you will grant us the Devisen of our Companies in more properer distances and that there be ann over seare appointed on that New Road and to take the Dwelers of the inhabitants it bein the old Road on Goos Creek Lane Levi Dawson's hands as the orders ofCourt and - then let Mr. Thos. Jorden's hands and Casen Brinson's be taken in to Mr. William Carraway's company and for Mr. Carraway to come with his hands from bears creek bring over Goos Greek as fir as the branch called ye Mill branch and Mr. William West to come with his company from bears creek bring to Joyn Mr. Carraways at the Mild branch and we work very well satisfied if your worships will be pleased to grant our Request which will be gratly to the Ease of all the companies more than as it Now Stands and allso wee have Rigisted the Distance of the roads in every part and what hands to every district to their west ease and benifitin working on every part which we humbely beg you will our most earnest request from , Sirs, your most Humbell Servants. September ye 9th day 1761
